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The Royal Hotel Bray

Today the Royal Hotel incorporates 1-5 Quinsboro Terrace on the Main Street in Bray, Co. Wicklow. In 1776 John Quin acquired 1 and 2 Quinsboro Terrace and established a 12 room coach inn called the Meath Arms Inn. In 1780 John Quin's son William acquired the Inn and renamed it Quin's Hotel.

The first Royal visitor to the hotel came in 1821, when King George IV was going to visit Powerscourt Waterfall. Other famous visitors include Charles Dickens, Daniel O'Connell, Sir Arthur Conan Doyle and John Nelson Darby the founder of the Plymouth Bretheren.

Thomas Cook the UK travel agent began package tours to Ireland in the 1840's and one of the hotels on the grand tour of Ireland was Quin's Hotel, Bray.

William Dargan the railway engineer who brought the Railway to Bray in 1854 was a shareholder in the hotel. William Dargan died in 1867 and his friend John Quin the grandson of the original owner of the hotel died in 1869. Mr Hayes the new owner of the hotel acquired the third house in the terrace and he engaged Mr John McCurdy to redesign the hotel. Mr McCurdy had just redesigned the Shelbourne Hotel in Dublin. Adam Findlater bought the hotel in 1900 and his wife was Agatha the daughter of John McCurdy who had designed the hotel thirty years earlier. In 1940, Mr Bill Cavey bought the hotel and developed the 92 guest rooms.

In 1958, Ardmore Film Studio opened in Bray and with its opening brought many more famous faces like James Cagney, Peter O'Toole, Katherine Hepburn, Elizabeth Taylor and George Peppard to the Hotel.

Number 4 Quinsboro Terrace which was The Ancient Order of Hibernians was acquired in 1947. It would take until 1962 for number 5 to be incorporated into the Hotel. Number 5 was the old police station for Bray, the police moved to new Garda station in 1930 and the building became a health centre until 1962. In 1981 Jim McGettigan, Proprietor of the McGettigan Hotel Group acquired the hotel and the guest of honour at the opening of the hotel was Mr John Hume, former SDLP leader, Nobel Peace Prize Winner and the Architect of Peace in Northern Ireland. In 2015 Olympic Gold Medal Winner Katie Taylor opened McGettigan's Bar at the Royal Hotel.

The hotel has also welcomed President Mary Robinson, His Highness the Aga Khan, Lady Baden Powel the founder of the Girl Movement, Martin O'Neill, former Celtic Manager, Golfer Shane Lowry, former ambassador for McGettigan's and the All Ireland winning Wexford GAA Hurling team.
